

## **Rules for the Perpetual trophy being presented by Bill & Chris Ros.**

Final draft. 27<sup>th</sup> Jan 2011

- 1 The horse must be a registered Purebred or Arabian Derivative.
- 2 The horse must be transferred or leased (in the records of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia) into the name of the rider or his/her husband/wife, mother/father, son/daughter or sister/brother.
- 3 Rides which are eligible for this trophy are any/all 160km rides in WA, during one calendar year but **EXCLUDING** any FEI rides.
- 4 The pre-ride heart rate is the deciding factor and is to accumulate over all of the above rides. These pre-ride heart rates are to be added together and the horse with the lowest total after the last 160 km ride is to be the winner.
- 5 The horse must complete all of the 160 km rides (on offer for the year) successfully (that is not vet out or be withdrawn or to have invasive treatment after vetting through).
- 6 If the trophy is not won in the year it is to carry over till the following year.
